A General Member shall be considered a voting member of the Association, eligible to hold office or to be elected to the BOARD.</p> <p>*ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP - Associate membership is open to those who do not meet the General membership requirements and to other individuals who are interested in environmental issues, ideas or technology. A Florida Associate shall be considered a voting member of the FAEP, not eligible to hold an office, but eligible to be elected to the BOARD. This category is especially applicable to recently graduated students. Those that do not have the requisite education background can remain an Associate member. Upon completion of the required professional experience, an Associate member will be granted General member status.</p>
